





School uniform should include:

Jumper	Navy blue V neck with academy logo
Shirt	White, long or short sleeve (not a polo shirt)
Clip on Tie	Red, navy and gold striped
Skirt	Navy, red and gold check
Trousers/Shorts	Grey, tailored school trousers
Socks	White with a skirt or grey with trousers
Tights	Navy blue
Shoes	Black (not trainers)

Please ensure all items of clothing, including coats and sportswear, are clearly named.

Children must wear sensible black school shoes without high heels or sling-backs for their safety in school and at play. It is not permitted for trainers to be worn to or from school, or during the school day, except at break-times.

No jewellery (including earrings) is to be worn in school.

If your child has hair long enough to be tied, it must be tied back for school.

- ✓ Set on Google Classroom, completed in books.
- ✓ Begins on 15th September
- ✓ Spellings set and tested every Monday.
- ✓ Maths set on Monday and due on Monday (Bi-weekly).
- ✓ English set on Monday and due on Monday (Bi-weekly).
- ✓ There are usually three levels of challenge (depending on the task) so that the children can choose the most appropriate level.
- ✓ Some maths classes may also still use Times Table Rockstars or MyMaths for homework. Links for these platforms will be provided on Google Classroom.

When they have achieved 10 stamps they will receive their bronze reading award and will start working towards their silver and gold awards.
