

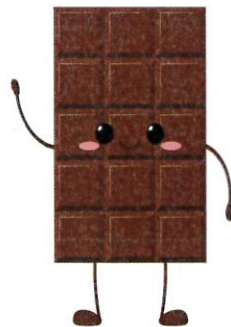

Homework

Year 3 and 5 parents will already be aware of the arrangements for homework following the meetings on Wednesday. More will be shared in the remaining meetings for Year 4 and 6 but in the meantime, an overview is provided below:

Year 3 and 4 children will receive 1 piece of homework set each week (English and Maths alternate weeks). This will be a 30 minute task and will be set on a Monday and handed in on a Monday. Spellings will be set every Monday and tested on a Monday. Regular reading is absolutely key and we encourage children to read to an adult or independently with adult supervision and recording at least 3 times a week.

Year 5 and 6 children will receive 1-2 pieces of homework set each week (English and Maths alternate weeks). This will be a 45 minute task/s and will be set on a Monday and handed in on a Monday. Spellings and reading are the same as Year 3 and Year 4.

Homework will continue to be set on Google Classroom and completed in homework books.

Homework will start on Monday 15th September with English.

Uniform and PE Kits

Children should wear PE kits on the days they are taking part in sport:

Year 3 - Wednesday and Thursday

Year 4 - Wednesday and Thursday

Year 5 - Tuesday and Friday

Year 6 - Tuesday and Friday

If children are doing a sports club after or before school, they can wear their PE kits to school.

Please may I remind you that hair which is long enough to tie back should be and that we prefer for earrings not to be worn to school. If they are worn, they should be plain gold/silver studs. Earrings must not be worn on PE days.

Parking

Please may I remind you that in order to keep our children and families safe when arriving and leaving school, we ask that you do not park in Cordon's Close or on the double yellow lines (the police have checked and issued fines in the past), but instead use the Church Lane Car Park. All parents have been emailed a permit from the school office, which allows you to park for 45 minutes at drop off and pick up times without having to get a ticket. The safety of our children is paramount - reversing and driving so close to the school, where children are crossing the road is very dangerous. Please support us to keep everyone safe!

Children walking to and from school

Whilst the policy is being updated, may I ask you to give written permission for your child to walk to/from school by completing a Google Form which can be shared with you via the school office.

Parent Pay

Letters have been sent home this week to all Year 3 parents and new families to the school. Please see details of instructions below to activate your account.

To ensure the smooth running of clubs, music lessons, activities and trips at Chalfont St Peter Academy we use a secure online payment website called ParentPay. Parents are asked to make all payments to school via the ParentPay website rather than sending cash or cheques into the school office.

New to ParentPay?

You will need to create your secure online account by visiting www.parentpay.com and using the unique activation username and password which will be sent home via a letter with all new Year 3 children and emailed to other new families. You will then be prompted to change these to something more memorable and private to you. If you have two or more children at a ParentPay

school, you only need to activate one account to create your 'main account' and then add your other children via the **Add a child tab** on your home page.

Already have a ParentPay account?

If you already have a ParentPay account, either with our school or another ParentPay school, you can simply login to that account and add your other children via the **Add a child** tab on your home page. You will need the activation username and password to do this.

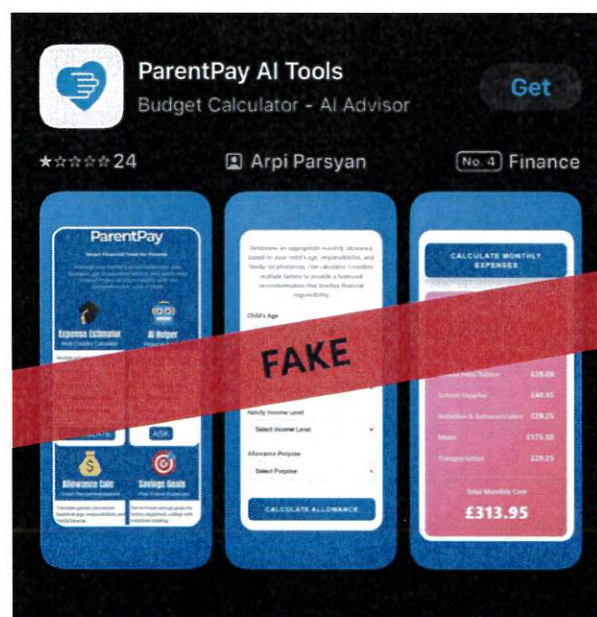
Please visit www.parentpay.com and activate your account via the **Account login** area on the home page of the site.

ParentPay holds an electronic record of your payments to view at a later date. Once you have activated your account you can make online payments straight away.

Important Notice – Fraudulent App Alert

We have been alerted to a fraudulent app in the Apple App Store that mimics ParentPay branding.



Security and safeguarding are top priorities at ParentPay Group, and we took swift action to report the app and are working closely with Apple to have it removed.

To date, we have recorded only 2 cases of affected parents.

- ParentPay **does not have an app available for download from any app stores**
- To use ParentPay, parents should visit <https://www.parentpay.com/> from a mobile phone or computer
- After logging in, parents can save a shortcut onto their phone's home screen

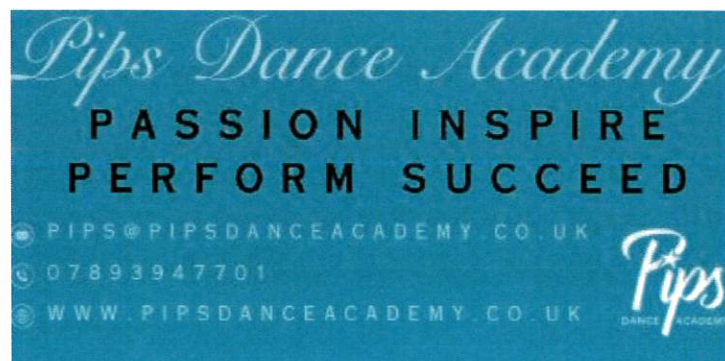

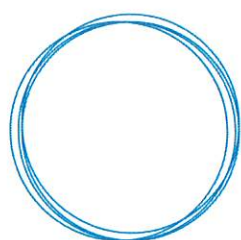
