## **Planned Roadworks - Market Place, Chalfont St Peter**

It has been brought to our attention that Buckinghamshire Highways will be carrying out footway reconstruction works along Market Place, Chalfont St Peter, from the High Street roundabout to Greggs/Bishops House.

The works are programmed to take place from Monday 27th April and it is anticipated the footway works will take approximately 27 days to complete, using a 24 hour footway closure. Multi way temporary lights and a temporary footway in the carriageway will be provided.

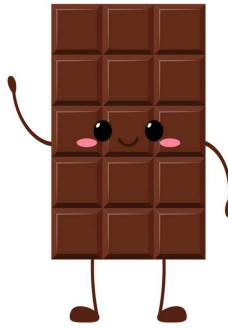

## **Year 6 SATs (week commencing 11th May)**

The children and staff have been working incredibly hard preparing for the Year 6 end of key stage 2 SATs which, this year, are scheduled for week commencing 11th May 2026. All Year 6 children across England will sit these tests during that week. During this preparation time, it is an opportunity for the children and teachers to work together to be familiar with the style of questioning whilst also revising Key Stage 2 topics.

I will be contacting any parents separately regarding their child's specific access arrangements where relevant and part of usual classroom practice.

## **Secondary Transfer Test - Information for current Year 5 parents**

Your child will have brought home an envelope before Easter containing information from Bucks about the Secondary Transfer Test (11+). Please note that this process is starting earlier than in previous years but the deadline for applying for secondary schools is still 31st October.

The envelope contains two letters:

1. A letter personalised for your own child informing you about the process to register to receive your child's result by email or the option of how to withdraw from the process.
2. A leaflet describing the timeline.

Please ensure you read the instructions carefully as there is a deadline of 2nd June to register or withdraw. Please also keep copies of these letters.

Mrs Valentine will be sending an email after Easter with information about the application process for modifications to the secondary transfer test which a few children may be eligible for.

Please also note that Mrs Alburg will be holding a meeting for Year 5 parents on Thursday 18th June at 7pm in the school hall to further share information about:

1. The secondary school application process and
2. The secondary transfer test (11+)

The meeting will be in two parts to allow parents to only attend the first part should they have decided for their child not to sit the secondary transfer test.

## **Year 5 Tudor Workshop**

Unfortunately our Tudor workshop due to take place this week was postponed as the leader is injured. We are looking into alternative dates and will let you know more as soon as possible.

This experience will be a valuable and engaging introduction to our new history topic and allows the children to explore a wide variety of activities and artefacts. They will be handling weapons and armour, trying their hand at archery, playing Tudor board games and even taking part in period dancing.

The cost for this workshop is £8.70, and it will take place at school. This has been added to ParentPay.

We are very much looking forward to the day.

## **Year 4 Osmington Bay Residential Trip**

Our long awaited trip to Osmington Bay is just over a week away. Please see below a few last minute reminders.

Could I remind you to check the kit list to ensure that your child has everything they will need whilst away, it is helpful for them to pack with you so that they know what they have in their bag/case. Please remember that they need a sleeping bag, pillow and pillowcase, these can be packed separately to the rest of their luggage if needed.

Please ensure that your child has no electronic devices (including phones) or additional food packed in their cases, we will provide treats for them whilst they are away so they do not need to bring anything additional. We have a number of children with allergies so it is really important that additional food is not in their bags.

On the morning of the trip your child will need to arrive in school at 8am wearing comfortable trousers, a t- shirt, their school PE sweatshirt, trainers or walking boots and a waterproof coat. They will be told which coach they are on the day before we travel.

Your child will need a water bottle and a small snack to eat at our stop at Winchester, this will need to be packed in a small day bag to take onto the coach.

Information about the trip will be shared on the school website and social

media. We will take photographs which will be uploaded to the website and social media. If you have requested that your child's photo is not on the website and social media we will ensure that this happens unless we hear differently from you.

Finally can I remind you that all medications for the trip must be in school by Wednesday 29th April. Medicines must be in their original packaging and an administration of medicine form must be completed and handed in with the medication. Please hand medication into the school office. We are unable to accept medication on the morning of the trip.

Those children not going to Osmington Bay will be expected to come into school on Wednesday 6th May, Thursday 7th May and Friday 8th May as usual, they will need to go into the Year 3 classrooms in the morning. I will let them know which class they will be with before we go. I hope that they will feel happy staying with the Year 3 teachers who they are familiar with already. Your child will be set some Maths and English tasks by their Year 4 teachers to complete each day as well as joining in with the Year 3 children for other lessons. There will not be any homework set by the Year 4 teaching staff as they will be in Osmington Bay, we would encourage your child to complete some Times Table Rockstar challenges.

## **Year 3 Roman Workshop**

We are pleased to let you know that on Tuesday 5th May, the children will be taking part in a Roman workshop day. This is being led by an external provider in school, and will be a day full of activities to enhance our Roman topic this term. The workshop will take place during the school day.

The children can come dressed in their usual school uniform - we will not be dressing up or taking part in any strenuous activities!

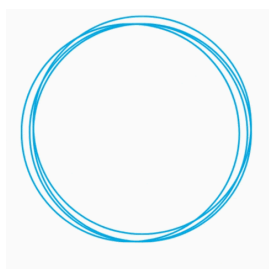
