# Medication

All medication should be handed in to the school office by Wednesday 3rd June at the very latest.

# Safety

The Summit Centre is licensed by the Adventure Activities Licensing Authority (AALA) and is regularly inspected as part of their internal health and safety audit programme.

The instructors are all fully trained and all are of course DBS checked.

The Summit Centre is also Learning Outside the Classroom (LOtC) accredited.

In addition, we complete our own risk assessments which have to be approved by the local authority.
